

**MINUTES FOR REGULAR COMMISSION MEETING HELD MARCH 19, 2007

UTAH**

***Consideration Of Payment Vouchers***

The commission reviewed vouchers #100809 through #100878 in the amount of one hundred twenty-seven thousand, one hundred seventy dollars and seventy-five cents (\$127,170.75). *Commissioner Harrison motioned to approve payments. Commissioner Wood seconded the motion. All commissioners voted aye and the motion passed.*

***Consideration Of Resolution No. 07-06 A Resolution To Elect To Declassify Duchesne County Voting Precincts As By-Mail Precincts***

Deputy Desormeau stated that this resolution was prepared in response to the voter's preference. She stated that last year the commission held by-mail elections for some of the smaller precincts that resulted in issues through mail delivery and etcetera. She stated that the state legislature pass a bill that allows counties to combine voting locations which would eliminate the problems that caused the county to go to by-mail voting. The commission reviewed the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-06**

A RESOLUTION TO ELECT TO DECLASSIFY DUCHESNE COUNTY VOTING PRECINCTS AS BY-MAIL  
PRECINCTS

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Duchesne County, Utah, is the proper authority to elect to classify Duchesne County voting precincts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fruitland (6:1, 6:2), Mountain Home (8:1), and Tabiona (20:1, 20:2) Duchesne County voting precincts were previously classified as by-mail voting precincts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Duchesne County, Utah, has been informed that the Fruitland Precinct (6:1, 6:2) may vote at the Fruitland Fire Station in Fruitland, Utah, that Mountain Home Precinct (8:1) may vote at the combined polling place located in Altamont, Utah, and that the Tabiona Precinct (20:1, 20:2) may vote at the Tabiona Town Hall in Tabiona, Utah; and

**WHEREAS**, this change is determined prior to February 1 of a regular even-numbered general election year,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved the Board of County Commissioners of Duchesne County, Utah, hereby elects that Duchesne County voting precincts Fruitland (6:1, 6:2) will vote at the Fruitland Fire Station in Fruitland, Utah, Mountain Home (8:1) will vote at the combined polling place located in Altamont, Utah, and Tabiona (20:1, 20:2) will vote at the Tabiona Town Hall in Tabiona, Utah.

Resolved Adopted and Ordered this 19th day of March 2007.

*Commissioner Wood motioned to approve the resolution. Commissioner Harrison seconded the motion. All commissioners voted aye and the motion passed.*
