Entries for the Demolition Derby are open to all men and women who are at least 16-years of age at the time of event. (NO EXCEPTIONS).

For the safety and fairness to all persons involved the following rules and regulations shall prevail.

**Limited to 60 cars this year.**

**First registered / first in**

Entries will be accepted until Tuesday, August 7, 2007.

Entry Fees are as follows:

### Drivers Rules

1.	Drivers who look under 18 years old must show proof of age.
2.	Each driver will be issued a pre-assigned number which must be displayed on both front doors and roof of the derby car.
3.	Drivers under age of 18 must have a signed release/consent form from parent or legal guardian.
4.	<b>No</b> jeeps, small trucks, pickups, four wheel drives or pre-74 Chrysler Imperials.
5.	Previously used Derby Cars must be pre-approved
6.	Drivers are allowed 2 pit members in pit area. No others allowed in pit area due to liabilities. No exceptions. (Included into entry fee, however if you want to sit in grand stand or bleachers you must pay the gate fee to do so.)
7.	Drivers and pit crew must sign an entry form and release waiver.
8.	Drivers and pit personnel under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance will not be allowed. Vehicles are subject to search.

### Rules of Competition:

1.	Drivers must wear a safety helmet, seat belt, and glasses at all times while in the arena.
2.	At the start the drivers must make a solid hit in reverse. No waiting.
3.	Any driver making a deliberate hit into an opponent's driver side door will be disqualified. Judges will determine this.
4.	Drivers must make a hit every 2-minutes or be disqualified
5.	No team driving or playing possum. No patty cake hits. Hits must be solid.
6.	Cars must display an orange flag (12" x 12", two feet above car and within reach of driver) to be pulled down by driver when out of competition
7.	Drivers and pit crew must attend pit meeting prior to Derby
8.	No profane or vulgar language in pit area or arena

9.	Once the free-for-all is reduced to 10-running cars, the 2-min. rule will go into effect and no other cars will be allowed to re-start
10.	Drivers must attempt to extinguish car fires if safe to do so.
11.	Judges decisions will be not overturned. Video playbacks will not be used.
<p><b>Car Preparations: All cars will be inspected before entering the pit area. Cars may also be inspected during event and after winning. Any alterations may be grounds for disqualification.</b></p>	
1.	Slogans, advertising, or lettering may be put anyplace on the car EXCEPT on the front doors. No profanity, vulgarity, or indecency on cars. Drivers assigned number must be on both front doors and roof.
2.	FACTORY GAS TANKS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE CAR. The maximum gas tank size will be 6 gallons. Gas tank must be secured in the back seat area with a leak proof cap. Must have a manual safety shut off valve in line next to tank. Electric furl pumps must have a separate cut off switch to shut off power to pump other than key switch.
3.	All excess fuses must be removed.
4.	Batteries must be relocated to passenger floor area, secured and covered.
5.	Radiators and fans may be removed but not relocated. Nothing heavier than hail screen may be placed on either side of radiator. All antifreeze must be removed. No auxiliary cooling systems may be added. All freon must be properly removed.
6.	All glass (including btm of doors and interior), lights, trim, hardware, and grills must be removed. All flammable materials must be removed from interior (carpets, headliner, back seat, etc.) Exception of driver door padding.
7.	Fenders may be trimmed around tires. No special bumpers, extra weights, or trailer hitchers. No reinforcements in bumpers, fenders, or frames allowed. Bolting to the car frame will not be allowed. Trunks must be empty. Need to see into trunk.
8.	Bumpers are to be welded. (Weld bumper to bracket and bracket to frame or bumper to frame. No reinforcing.)
9.	No modification to suspensions. (No lifts, added springs, spacers, or shackles).
10.	All doors welded shut. Trunk to be welded shut and (2) 1" x 3/8" max straps welded from top of trunk to bumper. Hoods can be welded, chained, or bolted with max of (6) bolts that are a max 3/4" with washers. Cannot go thru frame. (Max (2) 3/4" od thru hood into bumper.) If hood is welded shut, put (2) bolts or weld straps as per trunk.
11.	There must be a hole in the top of the hood over the air cleaner 12" and air cleaner must be on during the heats.
12.	Engine mounts may be solid.
13.	Car must have a bar welded from firewall to roof on front window. A pipe or square tube (3" od max and hollow must be mounted behind drivers seat with a 6" x 6" plate at the end of the pipe to be welded to the interior door post of the car for driver safety. You may take out the dash and run a 3" od pipe in its place.
14.	Seat belts and a fire extinguisher (mounted inside of the car within reach of the driver) are required. Driver door should be padded.
15.	TIRES: No chains, studded, tractor tires, skid tires. Maximum tire size allowed will be 235/85/15 or 700 x 15 8-ply <b>passenger car tire</b> . Tires can have tube but can only be filled with air. No fluids or solid rubber tires. Tires must have DOT stamp to be legal.
16.	All body mounts must remain in factory positions. No welding or alterations allowed.
17.	Pit personnel will not be allowed in arena during or after heats.
18.	No one under age 16 years are allowed in the pit area.
19.	All cars must have the ability to stop.

<b>Herby Derby – All above rules apply with the exception of:</b>	
1.	4-cylinder engines.
2.	Tires will be limited to OEM sizes.
3.	All regulations above apply.
4.	Two wheel drive.

All cars must pass inspections prior to entering the pit area. Car inspections will begin at 3:00 pm and end at 6:15 pm. All release forms must be signed and fees paid prior to entering pit area. Mandatory drivers meeting will be held at 6:30 pm. All cars will need to be removed from premises that night also, if not remove a \$50. fine will be imposed. Speeds in pit area must not exceed 5 MPH. Absolutely no alcohol or drugs tolerated.

Powder Puff winners have option to keep money for Powder Heat or collect \$100 for the heat and enter the Main Event.
