You must have completed and returned your application **and** included your POST Pre-Test scores **or** peace officer certified applicants need to include a copy of their certification and/or their copy of Utah State POST Waiver to be a qualified applicant.*

***Applications will not be accepted if they are returned without the required additional information.***

*The pool of applicants shall be renewed each year, beginning January 1st.*

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Performs a wide range of professional law enforcement duties intended to secure a safe environment of county citizens and to protect rights as established by federal, state and local laws, including, but not limited to: patrolling assigned roadways, responding and investigating a variety of citizen complaints, serving as agents of the court, and transporting prisoners and mental subjects/patients.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Applicants need to have taken the POST Pre-Test **AND** have scored at least 70% in all four categories **OR** certified applicants need to include a copy of their certification and/or their copy of Utah State POST Waiver to be considered. Check your local community college for information regarding the POST Pre-Test. Applicants need not be POST certified; however, certified applicants may receive preference. Applicants must be 21 years of age or older and possess a valid Utah Driver's License. Applicants must pass a pre-hire drug test and a physical. Applicants are subject to criminal records check.

**HOURS:**

Forty (40) hour work week. Schedule may vary.
